

The natural onsen comes from the ground where the 1,100 year old Garyu cherry tree is located and has been reborn as "Garyu no sato".



Onsen Garyu no Yu

Kurayama mountain one of "the famous 200 mountains in Japan" is in Ichinomiya town in Takayama. It has 1,529m high. The spring source gushing out from Kurayama Mountain is used for our Onsen.
The name of "Garyu no sato" came from "Garyu sakura" which is here in Ichinomiya.
You would be relaxed both mentally and physically in "Gensen Kakenagashi (hot spring water directly from the source, flowing through the bath tub without circulation)" hot spring.
The two tile murals in the large public bath. They based on famous paintings which is named "Spring" and "Winter". They are painted by Hiroshi Yamakoshi who is from Ichinomiya town.




